

Tutoring Services

Tutoring is a service that is coordinated through USC. The university's Center for Academic Support is continuously hiring USC-approved tutors throughout each semester for various courses.

Your first tutoring consultation must take place at the USC Center for Academic Support, which is located on campus in Student Union, Room 301. The following tutor schedule lists the courses in which tutors are available, the name of the tutor, and the time that tutoring sessions are held. If the course in which you need tutoring is not listed on the Online Tutor Schedule, please check back on a regular basis, as new tutors are always added to the schedule every Friday. The tutors specialize in teaching course material and preparing students for midterm and final examinations.

Once you have attended your first tutoring consultation on campus and found a tutor that you like, you can make future arrangements to meet with them at Tuscany.

We recommend meeting the tutors in a private meeting room in the Tuscany study lounges rather than letting them into your own apartment. The private meeting rooms are located in the Bob Marley Study Center and the Beatles Study Center, which are located on the 3rd and 5th floors, respectively.
